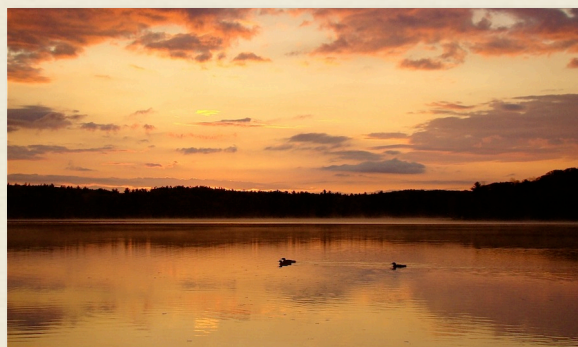

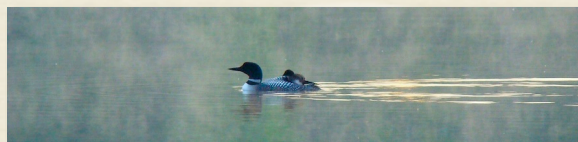

The only aquatic invasive here is the Zebra Mussel
brought in via the boat launch.
**To help maintain this pristine status we implore
everyone to:**

- ☒ Remove any visible mud, plants, fish or animals
from your boat and trailer before transporting.
- ☒ Never release plants, fish or animals into this lake
unless they came out of this lake, to include live bait.
- ☒ Don't dispose of fishing lines, nets or plastic items
in or near the water. Dispose of trash properly.
- ☒ Use suitable facilities for fish waste; do not dump
into our lake.
- ☒ Drain water from all your equipment and live wells
before transporting.
- ☒ Overnight stays on the lake on a boat are not
permitted. Campers may keep a licensed boat on
state land for the duration of their camping permit.
- ☒ Please do not anchor to swim or party, nor beach
your boat, in front of private homes. Your courtesy and
respect is appreciated.

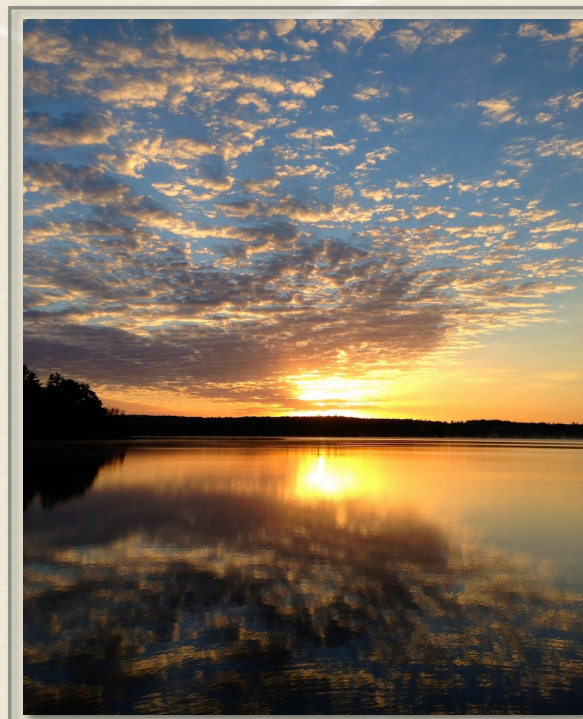
