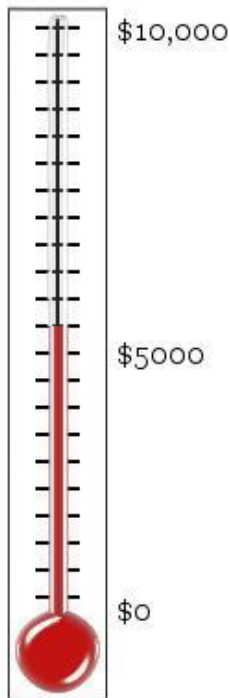


2017 Invasive Species Fundraiser for Ann Lake
