

You are ultimately responsible for knowing and understanding the provisions of the NR&EPA - Public Act 451, Sub-Chapter 5, Part 801 - Marine Safety and Part 802 - Personal Watercraft regulations. In 2008, Act 451, Part 802 - Personal Watercraft regulations was amended to facilitate increased PWC operational safety on Michigan waters. Effective October 1, 2011, persons under the age of 16, but no less than 14, may not operate Personal Watercraft on the waters of this state unless several conditions have been met. As of this date, all persons less than 14 years old are prohibited under any circumstances from operating a PWC.
